Math Challenge / Booster 7 and 8

What is an ovoid? It is the mathematical term to describe a three-dimensional oval shape, or an egg. Students in the math option classes had an opportunity to examine ovoids from an Easter perspective. They began by looking at the traditional art form of Ukrainian Easter eggs (pysanky). Students had a chance to learn that the colors and symbols have different meanings but central is the idea of using geometry and symmetry.

They also learned that the world's largest pysanky is located in Vegreville, Alberta and the structure itself is a mathematical and engineering feat. Students then incorporated geometry and symmetry to decorate their own Easter eggs. Check out some of the results above!
